



## 2021 BCGBA Competitions

### **Senior County Championship.**

- Due to restrictions and logistics of playing a County Championship match the Isle of Man would not be expected to participate.
- Where possible the Referee's Association will appoint a local referee.
- In all rounds it will be optional as to whether a buffet will be provided. Consultation should take place between the competing teams as to whether it is viable.
- All other Senior County Championship rules will still be applicable.
- All Counties to be advised that prize money will be significantly reduced.
- Usual Match Fee per County of £70.
